# *PROJECT IDEA*



The idea of the project is to bring people from different European countries together, in order to learn more about the Human Library / Living Library methodology. Specifically, we want to look at digital implementations and similar interactive activities.

# *THE MAIN AIM...*

... of the project is to empower participants in developing competencies related to promoting respect for diversity through online-methods.

## **Objectives**

- Provide knowledge about stereotypes, prejudices, stigmatisation and exclusion to youth workers
- Help youth workers analyse their work related to issues surrounding stigmatisation and discrimination
- Support youth workers to gain competences regarding the organisation of digital Human/Living Libraries and all the (digital and interactive) tools
- Support the inclusion of minorities, migrants, and refugees through digital means
- Publish a short guide with best practices for digitally running conversation-based communication events along with the (side-) tools necessary for other organisations


# *PARTICIPANT PROFILE*

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# ***SELECTION OF PARTICIPANTS***

Each partner organization selects 4 participants: 1 Human / Living Library organizer, 1 volunteer, 1 Human Book and 1 person matching any of the previous roles. Gender balance is taken into consideration. It is strongly recommended that the same persons go to the training in Poland and the evaluation seminar in the Netherlands. The final confirmation of the selection of the participant needs to be done by the organizing team (Alex).



# VENUES

For the training in Poland, we will stay at the International Youth Meeting Centre in Krzyżowa: [www.krzyzowa.org.pl](http://www.krzyzowa.org.pl). There are 3 person bedrooms. Arrival is 1 November by 18:00 hrs, departure is 7 November after breakfast.



For the evaluation seminar in the Netherlands, we will stay at the Olde Vechte in Ommen: [www.oldevechte.nl](http://www.oldevechte.nl). There are 3/4 person bedrooms. Arrival is 4 March 2022 18:00 hrs, departure is 7 March after breakfast (dates yet to be confirmed).





# *FINANCIAL INFORMATION*

Thanks to Erasmus Plus funding, the costs for the accommodation (sleeping) and food is covered. There is also a travel reimbursement, as a fixed amount, irrespective of the actual travel costs:



For traveling to Poland, per person, both ways:

- Belgium, Netherlands and Italy: 210 euro
- Czech Republic: 134 euro

For traveling to the Netherlands:

- Poland, Italy and Czech Republic: 210 euro
- Belgium: 134 euro

# *HOW TO GET THERE*

## **Poland**

From Wrocław airport take bus nr 106 and get out at the bus stop Dworcowa. The main train station (Dworzec Główny) is nearby. Take a train to Krzyżowa station (you can check the train schedule and buy an online ticket at [www.pkp.pl/en](http://www.pkp.pl/en)); the train takes about an hour. Get off the train at Krzyżowa station; it's a 10 min walk to the site (the address is Krzyżowa Foundation for Mutual Understanding in Europe; Krzyżowa 7, 58-112 Grodziszczce).

## **Netherlands**

From Schiphol you buy a train ticket to Ommen at the ticket machine. It takes about 1,5 hrs. From Eindhoven airport you go first with a bus to Eindhoven Station (bus ticket at the machine). There you buy a train ticket to Ommen at the ticket machine. It takes about 2,5 hrs. After Ommen station it is a 15 min walk (Address: Olde Vechte, Zeesserweg 12).
