### PARTNER ORGANIZATIONS:

Our organization does not agree that partner organizations charge fees for participation (participant fee). Our organization does not collect any money. The collection of fees from participants will be tantamount to the termination of further cooperation.



We expect partnership to be involved in every stage of the project. One of the most important is the stage of preparation of participants.

As part of the first meeting that will be with parents and participants will address the following issues:

- familiarizing parents with the idea of the Erasmus + Program and its main objectives;
- familiarizing with the schedule;
- discussing the rules for participation, rights and obligations of the parent and child; discussion of the risks associated with the meeting;
- signing consent to participate in the child's project;
- signing consent to use the child's image for the purposes of the project; getting acquainted with the trip regulations and accepting them;
- filling out the participant's card containing information about diseases, allergies, diet with contact to caregivers;
- sharing contacts (phone, email) with leaders / coordinator;
- question session.

As part of the meetings with participants, we will discuss the following issues: - cultural differences;

- we will discuss the principles of safe participation in the meeting (alcohol, drugs, sexual contacts, health and safety rules, fire protection etc.);
- communication barriers, use of language in practice, ways of quickly learning vocabulary; participants will allocate responsibilities among themselves;
- we will discuss the action plan and create a detailed work schedule;
- we will create a risk prevention plan and discuss the risks that may occur on the project; we will create a contingency plan, i.e. procedures for dealing with unexpected situations; we practice the methods chosen by the participants;
- we will create a list of materials necessary for the project;
- we will prepare an online document on which participants will be assigned to (international) rooms (Poland will prepare and your participants just enter their names)..

In our organization, leaders are responsible for preparing participants with organization and coordinator. Involvement of a person not related to the trip to Poland is possible, however, please keep them in touch with the leader, so that he has information about what is happening



in the group. Paweł Skoczek and Aleksy Kaczmarzyk will be in contact with people responsible for preparing the participants. We'll help with anything. Preparation requires a lot of time, so we ask you to start the activities related to the list of participants after receiving the InfoPack and familiarizing yourself with it.

One of the important elements of the meeting is the promotion of the project, which we have to document in the form of photos, screenshots. Please promote the project in the media before, during and after the meeting. Please note that the budget comes from the Erasmus+ Programme. Another element is the dissemination of the results of the meeting. It looks different in each project, so we will discuss a detailed plan with participants.

# PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION

#### **INSURANCE**

Every participant of our project needs to have European Health Insurance Card. Remember that it is not possible to take part in our project without EHIC. Our organization will buy an additional insurance.

The Yellow Sheep Foundation is obliged to take out insurance for all participants. For guardians, a third party liability will be purchased additionally.

We're starting this project because our towns don't have much going on with graffiti, except for such exchanges. Joining in means more than just learning to paint. It's a chance to meet new people, learn about their way of life, and practice English. We also hope to learn more about street art in our areas.
