Virtual reality (VR) is a technology that immerses users in a simulated environment, typically through the use of headsets and sensory devices, providing a sense of presence in a virtual world. In non-formal education settings for youth workers working with disadvantaged groups, VR can be a powerful tool for experiential learning.

Integrating VR into non-formal education for youth workers working with disadvantaged groups can enhance learning outcomes, promote inclusivity, and empower participants to overcome barriers and achieve their full potential. During the training we will get acquainted with the Library method, we will introduce its procedures and learn how to use it in practice. We will also focus on working with VR and how to use it
