Nearly 20 years have passed since the biggest enlargement of the European Union. In 2004, all the V4 countries joined the EU on 1st of May 2004. This means that a generation has grown up without any memories outside of the EU. In all V4 countries, the EU membership was positively perceived and welcomed. But what is the situation now, in these instable, unpredictable days? How nowadays youth think about the EU and V4?

With this project we offer a **state-of-the-art curriculum** on new media awareness, an **innovative learning mobility activity** with significant local impacts, and an **extensive online campaign**. 
You will be accommodated in 4 bed-rooms with comfy bunk beds and shared bathrooms, divided by gender.

You will be accommodated in 3-4 bed-rooms with comfy beds and shared bathrooms, divided by gender. 3 meals per day will be provided at the venue.




If you would like to arrive to Budapest or leave Lodz 1-2 days later, you are allowed to do so, but on your own cost (accommodation and meals).
