


Key project tasks



One pre-departure meetings will take place between Marttinen's international youth work team, supporting organization and volunteers.


Regular mentoring sessions will guide volunteers through their projects, ensuring valuable insights and skill development.


Continuous support from Marttinen's staff will be available, addressing any challenges and providing encouragement throughout the project.
